### Gus Jian Zhu MW, DipWSET

Gus has been instrumental in advancing wine education and science. He began his journey as a wine educator under the mentorship of Fongyee Walker MW and Edward Ragg MW, and has since become a pivotal figure in wine research and education. After completing his WSET Level 4 Diploma in Wines and Spirits at WSET School London, he went on to achieve a Master of Science in Viticulture and Enology from UC Davis and became the first Chinese national Master of Wine in 2019.

Gus is a research scientist at Harv 81 Group, where he oversees quality control and sensory research on cork and oak products. His book, *Behind the Glass: The Chemical and Sensorial Terroir of Wine Tasting*, has been acclaimed for making wine science accessible and engaging.

Gus's innovative work in sensory science and oak-wine interactions has been presented at seminars and masterclasses worldwide. He played a key role in expanding WSET qualifications in China and in the US and continues to inspire wine professionals and enthusiasts globally with his dedication and enthusiasm.
